Introduction to Policies

The People's Political Power Party of Canada will maintain the integrity of the Constitution of Canada, ensuring to give all people security, justice and peace through the establishment of trust. The Party aims to develop real participatory democracy, requiring a moral obligation on the part of representatives of the Party to serve their members. In such, the Party promotes a centralist view to bring unity between opposing views, and to bring individual abilities forth to develop Canada as a role-model for nations of the world.

We've all heard the expressions, 'Peace begins in the heart!' and 'Peace begins at home!' First there must be Peace in our hearts and in our homes. Peace now! Peace, not tomorrow but immediately. We must 'quit' the wars that are being waged in the home, in our communities, everywhere in Canada. Refusing to wage personal, business or governmental 'war' on one another is saying, 'I love the people!' And then you believe it is possible and you love each other and you talk together.

We are here to join with you and to make possible an era where we can all say together as *one* (as members of the same heart), 'I love my country and the world!' And when you have this love for others, love guides you to learn and to share together. It will be the *Spirit* of Love that guides us in all we think, do and say.

It is time to believe and to love your country. If you don't listen together there is nothing that can be done. 'Blue' or 'red' or 'green' or 'orange' – it doesn't matter. The people are more important than 'colours'. It is so fascinating when you finally love all people from any country because now it doesn't matter if you are poor or rich – you learn to love each other by sharing with one another.

Policy 1: Respect for Women

True love and respect between all people will guarantee a happiness and productivity in this country that has never been seen before - anywhere. It is the cornerstone of true freedom. Without love and honesty, the country will never function to the satisfaction of its people who have such a desire for truth, love, honesty and fairness. On the issues of abortion, pro-life and pro-choice, we must all agree to one attitude.

We are here to first bring value as top priority to woman: the mothers, mothers-to-be, mothers that were. When you degrade woman and you promote the dissection of the motherly value of woman by pornography; promoting drugs, alcohol; and anything else by lack of respect to further degrade woman, it is an insult to the family; and in such an assault unto the whole nation. In promoting this kind of garbage you are defaming the character of woman and you have the answers as to why we have abortions, homosexuality, criminality and the breakdown of the family and where women have to compete in fashion with the young girls out there in order to keep their men home.

On the issues of abortion: *there is always a man behind an abortion.* And who screams against women having an abortion if not the men who don't want to take responsibility for their child? By their promoting contraception or the 'morning after' pill, it is plainly telling women: *"I just want to use you. And afterwards, get lost."* Women feel they have to compete in fashion with the young girls out there in order to keep their men home and we will pull women out of this mentality. When women will be respected, you won't have to talk about abortion, broken down families, criminality, sexual abuse, incest and all forms of lesser values.

We want respect for the young girls that are mothers-to-be and we will ban any form of dissection of the value of woman: be it in pornography, in literature, in prostitution or in forcing women to sexual ventures to survive. We will make these things criminal activities but we will provide opportunities to the nation to be educated *in the true beauty and value of the motherly in woman at any age, from birth unto death.*

This new respect of woman will establish a beautiful and respectful home environment where all within – women, children and men are happy and secure. The feeling of wellness and balance that has begun in the family will continue until all of Canada is transformed. Thus Canada will be renewed and re-born through respect of woman.

We don't want that trash of pornography (anything that reduces woman to less than her true/motherly value) in this nation anymore, whether it comes from Europe or the United States. Women will be respected in this nation and you will keep your trash on your grounds. It is not about religion, it's about respect - absolute respect and Canada will become the envy of the world because *Canada will be a paradise for all. This is our intent.*

Policy 2: The First Nations

Healing for All Canadians

Another important policy is to resolve the issues between the First Nation people, the Government of Canada and the Churches. The resolution of this issue will come with healing on all sides. It is not an issue that only directly affects the said parties but all the people of Canada. Everyone is directly affected by the continuation of racism, partiality, hate, lack of love and domination of a race. Likewise, we will all be affected by the end of such things, for each one of us plays a part in bringing healing into one another's lives and the whole of our nation.

It is not sufficient to payout land claims and monies for Residential Schools, which could further aggravate the situation in that the people remain secluded, literally refused into the unity that we speak of. Words mean nothing when our actions do not mirror our words. Apologies and laws are not enough to bring change and hope. It must start with reconciliation, which starts with recognition of errors of the past, followed by change through actions (not words) for the betterment of tomorrow for all people. Trust is important in establishing a partnership and trust is only earned by our words becoming a reality through the love we show for others in our actions.

Once we have these things established, not by laws but by desires in everyone's heart, our next step is to give everyone an opportunity to begin a brand new life in Canada: from criminals to the handicapped; to the people of all nations that are here. Our politicians could get away with fraud of millions of dollars, but we have an incredible plan to cut off criminality, to increase the revenue for the nation and to decrease the income tax system *completely* over a ten-year period, where we could prove that we could increase revenue. In such, giving more money to the people to spend by cutting down taxes, where the nation will recuperate through the increasing economy from the taxes on goods. Everyone will have work; where we could eliminate the entire welfare system, to some exceptions that are absolutely warranted but to give dignity to everyone and the pleasure to live a life that they could build without limitation.

Rights & Responsibilities

The Treaties remain as long as the green grass grows, the waters flow and the sun shines. For now the Treaties seem only as an enforcement to those who must care for a people. The Treaties should be honoured out of love for a people, not by obligation. This covenant can be a covenant made to all the peoples of Canada; for all of us prosper from the earth, from its water and the sun above.

It is a human right to have good housing, clean water and more than just the basic necessities to survive. The third world countries we see on television are not an ocean or country away, it is in our backyard. Reserves are in dire need of change. They must become communities where everyone can do their part to bring balance and prosperity not only to their family, friends, and neighbours but also to the nation as a whole.

To really help someone you teach them how to fish rather than to fish for them every day so they don't starve. When you invest in teaching someone their value and importance in a nation, you are therefore making a good investment that in the future will be an asset rather than a liability.

By this the First Nations could use their rights to use their land for the natural resources it provides; not only the natural resources of oil, gold, gas and water, but the real natural resource, the land itself. Farming, agriculture and greenhouses will be encouraged to build a resourceful and self-sustaining income for more well-balanced and fruitful communities. Education in these fields will be provided. And once educated, the practice and responsibility of making it become a reality in their communities will be in their hands. The First Nations hold within their grasp the ability to produce and market wheat, fruit, vegetables and livestock for their own communities and all of Canada.

Without the wheat board and the other organizations of managing the monopoly of prices, they will have the freedom to sell their goods and services to the public and the public may have the pride and knowledge of having brought something 'Canadian Made' without the extra costs of importation and tariffs.

All businesses within remote communities, whether aboriginal organizations or not, will work together for the betterment of their communities and all of Canada. Food prices will be carefully monitored so that excessive profits and gains do not exist while a community is being deprived of necessary nutrition. If there are extra costs to transport and distribute **essential** food items then the government will subsidize the cost for these remote communities. Essential food items should be available at a price attainable for the any consumer wherever they might live. In this plentiful nation of Canada, none of its family members should ever go hungry.

Church & State

Many years ago the First Nations lived as a strong people. But when they were stripped of their rights: knowledge of their culture so was the knowledge of their identity. With healing and forgiveness comes wisdom and strength of oneself. When you discover who you are and your ability to make a difference into your own life and that of others, unity begins. You begin to have the strength to climb out of the despair that you and your people are in, whether created by your own actions or that of others.

The arrogant silence from the people, who speak of God and do nothing for evangelization, will be forced by a movement of reconciliation to come forth and heal with the people. If not, they will find themselves at an end by their lack of honesty and love. Their tyranny of paternalism will end permanently when the one voice of many people in one Spirit who stand together in unity will have spoken.

The federal government of Canada, in its earliest stage in colonization through the recommendations of the King of France and of the British throne, has paid institutions in the

priesthood and diverse religions to **de-Indianize the Native people**. These organizations were paid so much 'per head' to take away their culture, their origins, and their language.

The government has partaken and used the churches for the defamation of a character of the First Nations people. In the past they have invested in the churches to dismantle and to try and destroy a people. Therefore, the government must partake with those who have dismantled with them the First Nations people to fix the damage that has been caused to this Nation by re-investing through the churches (as they have done so in the past) and be forced to commit all funds necessary to bring a new teaching, schooling satisfying to all nations where the true essence of your God shall be known to all people by truth, justice and fairness. It is time for a new teaching for the whole Nation under the supremacy of God. (*Check the constitution.*)

The churches cannot be blamed alone and the government cannot leave the responsibility to its own (those that were employees of them). They were the employers; they are equally responsible for the full restoration of this nation. An international court of law would find this government guilty of genocide against the First Nation people.

In order to move forward there must be reconciliation for it is then that *the family can, and will be*. It is the desire of everyone to have a family environment where they feel that they belong. By working together reconciliation can take place to bring unity to the new Family of Canada.

To the First Nation people

We can, by working together, make these things happen but everyone will have to learn to walk together as one people. We must learn from one another and throw away the errors and arrogance of the past by opening our heart to forgiveness and love for the importance of making a better tomorrow.

We are all family and together we can make the vision of the medicine wheel (all races as one) a reality. A strong Canada cannot function with divisions and borders between its members. Canada must be a united family where all its members work together with equality, respect, peace, love and trust.

Policy 3: International Partnerships

The Banking System & Peace, not War

Canada will pay off its debts and will no longer be dominated by a world banking system; where now another currency is circulating to try and override all currencies of the world, through a system of absolute corruption.

International affairs, under the PPP: Canada will never become a military zone. Canada will never be dominated by other nations who believe that they have the power to turn a peaceful country into a military zone for their own purpose and gain. When we work together we can build bridges between nations and that creates peace not war.

Ending Global Poverty by Respect

Canada can become a role model of respect and love for the family and for all nations that can bring about a resolution to all world problems. We must see other nations as extended family, instead of 'dealing with other nations'. We are not here to interfere with life in any nation (sterilization, abortion, contraception, and other means of interrupting life), but to bring more respect to the process of life. There is no reason for over-population, much less of poverty. When you bring respect for woman and the family, you have all problems resolved: criminality, broken families, drugs, alcohol, abortions and all. The answer is **respect**.

Open Dialogue & Transparency

Communication is key in rebuilding broken or burnt bridges. Open and honest dialogue is important in creating a new vision by the agreement of all. We firmly believe *that if anybody loses, nobody wins*. It is by peace, love, equality and respect that partnerships are built. It is this kind of partnership that will bring prosperity to all sides, all nations, all peoples and the world.

Open dialogue on all sides will be encouraged and if we must lock ourselves up in a room until we come to an agreement (as the cardinals do to elect a Pope or as jurors do to come to an unanimous agreement) then it shall be done for the betterment of all peoples. We look forward to meeting every one of the leaders of the world whether they are terrorist, Capitalists, Freemasons, Illuminati, Christians or Muslims. Love is love. Justice is peace. And such will be.

It is time that the G8 start looking at a family environment instead of hiding behind closed doors with secret agendas that will be denounced once we are out there. If you have something good that will benefit all, why hide it? In hiding the true intent of your plans you are out-rightly telling us that what you have to offer is only for the few and will not be accepted if exposed. This kind of secret society will not be tolerated; for it will be the power and voice of the people that will be heard, not the voices of these few 'elites', though this new way of peace, love, equality and respect is for them too.

A friendship between neighbouring nations must be made with total trust and transparency.

A nation (a government) must be totally transparent, where the elected are held accountable and where its citizens can see and trust where their investment into the nation is going as the economy and the home become balanced and safe. If your own citizen cannot trust and depend on its government, how can you ask neighbouring countries for the same?

Free Trade

Why is the word ‘free’ in ‘free trade’ when a nation is exploited for their goods and services?

The exploitation of one nation by another is always to the benefit of the exploiter. You cannot bring two nations together by one being lesser; nor can you come under the disguise of a benefactor and then bleed a nation of its resources. Every nation must become equally important and valued for each have their own gifts, goods and services that provide the stability and growth of each nation.

When two nations agree to Free Trade it should not leave one nation’s dollar of less value, nor leave one of the nation’s citizens paying double the retail price, as Canadians pay in American outlets in Canada, when if we manufactured more of our own products and sold them through our own retail stores the cost would be half to the consumers. In addition, there would be more jobs created and thus, more wage earners and ultimately more consumers which would add to the Canadian economy.

Policy 4: The Family

The main goal of this party will satisfy every woman of this nation as well as the spirit of family. By attaining this goal, we will reduce excessive costs of social services, the welfare system, criminality, matrimonial problems and emotional problems. The people will be the main asset of the nation. We invite you to become members of this ideal that must be ours, because you have become *our family*. We would like to outline issues which we see as priorities.

Our priority is first the family where unless we re-establish the absolute value and need of a family structure, we cannot deal with the problems in society such as crime, abortions, and the breakdown in family - all problems that politicians are attempting to overshadow with promises.

By Respect - Not Force

We will never permit forcible ventures such as the imposition of microchips in the human because we don't trust anymore. That is the worst form of imposing a structure upon people where all our previous leaderships have abused the taxpayers of this nation for personal gain and by their control of humanity. We will never accept such, but we will have our own destiny as a nation under the umbrella of love **through respect for the family** that will bring respect to the children and all the people of this nation without the imposition of mechanical means.

Our Nation becomes the Family of Canada

Our agenda, first of all is to make of Canada a family: not a nation or a country, but a family. Unless Canada becomes a family it could never be structured in the way of human rights, and we intend to establish such. For example, you cannot have a museum of human rights in Winnipeg when in reality there are no human rights for the poor, the destitute; or where you do not have absolute respect for the family beginning by woman of all ages.

Building Hope for the future

Our priority is to give everyone to look forward to tomorrow without pressures and divisions between people. Everyone will set his/her dream, his/her goal and will be encouraged to go for it. And we will remove the wasted time of polluting the minds of the young with sexuality, drugs and alcohol; to give them to look forward to a beautiful home environment where all the young women of this nation will be thankful to whoever they pray to, if they do for being recognized as the founders of Canada, because everyone was born through a woman. Women are beyond the founders of the Confederation because there are no federations of cons in their heart. This is the Duplessis way and we say: "*No way!*"

The value of the family will be understood as the strength and foundation in cutting health care costs, diminishing criminality, giving a break to the environment, and re-kindling personal dreams. The family structure is the basis of *home care*. When you see happiness, you *become happiness*. **Canada must become a family** where we will have role models in young

men wanting to look after their families, their mothers and fathers; and young women dreaming up *happiness* by the reality of the example of their own family structure to continue the legacy of a true marriage between people and their nation.

The new structure of a new Canada will make the members of this nation not only believe in it but partake in building it. Because of the family breakdowns on accounts of the systems of the past, many have been deprived of education and opportunities to learn a trade or to function in the fields that they would like because of monetary limitations and a lesser sense of value because of the pressures of broken-down families.

We are reducing our population and increasing perversion, where this manipulation (by the supposedly great men of the world) plunges nations into chaotic ventures like drugs, alcohol and sexuality. This makes a takeover much easier; because a drunk man will like you if you give him beer, but he won't if you try to sober him up unless you give him something better than what you have given him so far. And we will give him better. We will help him regain his balance beginning with a new life at home: peaceful, secure and loving beginning by true respect where mere survival is replaced by *hope for the future*.

Investing in our Youth / Education – not poverty

We will invest in our youth and in all the people of this Nation through education, so that all will have the opportunity to strengthen and multiply the natural resources of this country – our youth. The education system will be totally changed. We will develop a national education system, using the media and technology, where everyone will have an opportunity, at a much lower cost, to learn to grow. Naturally they will have to write exams on what they have learned but it will be in a peaceful environment such as home.

In this way, we will begin a foundation of establishing human rights in everyone's heart without the need of expensive museums. Our priority is to give everyone to look forward to tomorrow without pressures and divisions between people. Everyone will set his or her dream, a goal, and will be encouraged to go for it.

Poverty will be removed through education as an investment of the nation into the people by the contribution of the people to provide an education for their children without having to re-finance everything they have so that their children may have an education. Some of the young have turned to drugs and crime because they are told, 'There is no money for you or for your future.'

I know for some of the young it will seem 'impossible' that everything could be cheaper and for them to be happy. It is time now for the young to believe what we say because we are here for the whole country. We cannot and will not forget you, the young, for you are the Dream of a better tomorrow for all.

Family Day

The structure of the family will bring back home the street children, the husbands or wives that have gone astray; where we intend to give back to this nation a *family day*, the seventh day. **It is not religiously. It is giving the family an opportunity of unity.** In such, everyone will have a reason to go home, to express their feelings and emotions, where the structure of parenting will be the main pillar of our society by teaching our young the joy and beauty of being parents and not 'just' a parent.

Every family will have an opportunity to sit together, to strengthen each other, to worship as they please or not, but the family value will be restored for the atheist as much as for the religious because it will be a Family Day.

If defied, there will not be fines but instead, businesses will be shut down permanently. Every family will have an opportunity to sit together, to strengthen each other, to worship as they please or not. Businesses will be closed, except for emergency services.

A Healthy Canada

If no one sees the value of the family as important, healthcare costs will increase as the experts tell us so well (without citing the true cause); criminality will increase; sexual abuse will increase, pedophilia will increase, lusting will increase; and the will to live will decrease. If these costs keep increasing, we will have less people contributing to taxes, since we are now banning life for the pleasures of flesh.

Our Seniors

We have a plan for Senior Citizens that will prove successful for them and for all Canadians. Because of their many contributions to the wealth of Canada by their many years of service, employment and paying taxes, it is time that we recognize the contributions our Elders have made in a way that will benefit them in their retirement years by reducing the psychological and financial stress that soaring costs have on fixed income recipients.

Any Senior who wishes to retire at age 65 will not be expected to pay property taxes in his or her own residence. Removing the property tax would apply only at the residence in which they live. Any income property would still be subject to property taxes because of the supplementary income.

Removing this financial burden from our Seniors would allow them to retire, opening doors to the young increasing opportunities for more work and more jobs that otherwise, seniors would have to keep to pay their property tax and it would allow the young greater accessibility to building their family lives.

Finally, retirees could take a rest without having the pressure of taxation on property. No seniors (under an income ceiling that will be fixed) will have to pay property taxes, in order to reward

them for their contributions in having built the nation. Together we can create an environment where people would look forward to retirement and we intend to make Canada this beautiful.

It is time to show respect for the contributions that our Seniors, our Elders have made; not only in paying taxes or contributing to the economic well-being of Canada, but also for their investment into the family structure of Canada by the wisdom they share and by their leadership in continuing to be the examples of commitment, love and respect of others that they have shown throughout their lives. Now, with a restructured home base (where the family is central) the health conditions of our Seniors and all will change.

Volunteerism by our Seniors will be encouraged. With their many skills and experiences, be they spiritual, domestic, vocational, or governmental our Elders will be encouraged to share their wisdom with others. People will look forward to their 'senior years' with optimism and enthusiasm. This will enrich not only their own lives but the lives of all Canadians where there will be no more 'gaps' in the generations. We will remove the stigma of 'getting old' by respecting them as the gifts that they are. We will remove 'ageism' from Canada and become a role model to the rest of the world.

To our Elders and Seniors we say, *Are you retired? Would you like to be re-tired? If so, here are some new wheels for you to get rolling.*

Policy 5: Immigration

Rights & Responsibilities of all Canadians

Canada is filled with culture, from our own beginnings here in Canada and from those who have come abroad to start a new life here. We stay true to the constitution that everyone has their fundamental freedoms: freedom of religion, freedom of expression, freedom of thought, freedom of belief, freedom of peaceful assembly and freedom of association.

In this family of Canada that we can become, we value each other in respect, peace, love and equality welcoming those who wish to be in this family framework. As such they will be given respect, love, peace and equality as it will be asked of them.

But freedom does not mean we can do what we want without taking into consideration the consequences of our actions. If our freedom of religion, expression, thought or belief infringes on the rights of others: whether it be in disrespecting women, disrespecting the family, putting yourself and others in danger, or thinking you have dominion over someone (race, gender or creed), it is then the cost is too great. To explain: We believe in rights and freedoms but when that right disrespects another it is then that respect overrides freedom. Abuse of any kind towards the family, women or children, will not be tolerated, no matter the religion or non-religion.

With absolute freedom comes responsibility and respect of others. When you are a citizen or wish to be a citizen of this nation, Canada, you exercise your right to these freedoms, but you are also taking into consideration the wellbeing of each citizen, whether they are your family, friend or neighbour. We are all equal and together we can learn from one another to become a stronger family.

Equal Opportunity & Respect for All

We welcome all minorities, to share their culture and skills with us, as we share ours with them. Together we will create a productive nation, a land of rich cultures and diversity built on mutual respect. Everyone will have work, dignity and the pleasure to live a life that they could build without limitation. Through respect of each other, we will work together and show surpluses that have never been seen before in the provinces, territories or in the nation.

Everyone will have the opportunity to rebuild their lives: those we label as ‘mentally ill’, those we label as ‘criminals’, and all those we label as ‘lesser’ than ourselves. For example, the high cost of ‘criminality’, caring for the ‘mentally ill’, caring for all ‘lesser’ (seniors, ‘welfare cases’, ‘addicts’ etc.) will be reduced by restructuring the family value and perhaps for the first time, for those who have never known family values because of the lack of respect for the family. And in such, open the doors by becoming the fathers of this confederation to be the parents of Canada; whether the people are Inuit, Aboriginal, French, English or any nationality that

has sought from this nation, a dream, a possibility. You cannot build a nation without a family structure for all people.

Policy 6: Healthcare

The Cure of all Diseases

Are we truly interested in preventing diseases, rather than just to find some medical reasons or ways to put in remission diseases that could be eliminated, if we have enough care to understand their origins? The origins of all diseases take place in the human structure (anatomy), triggering defects because of the lack of willingness to live, which also triggers the purpose of existence only to survive rather than live happily.

The high cost of healthcare is due to not taking care of our health! We have a plan, for everyone's healing from the continuous burden of diseases. Healing begins in a desire to live, triggered by hope.

The value of the family will be understood as the strength and foundation in cutting health care costs, diminishing criminality, giving a break to the environment and re-kindling personal dreams.

As a Nation, we will become healthy again. **Again, healing begins in a desire to live, triggered by hope.** We will provide instructions for how to really care for one another. Caring takes its roots in love. In the Canada that we offer, as fear and lack of hope diminishes, the immune system of individuals will become replenished.

The Spirit of caring that begins in the home will spread into healthcare facilities themselves where everyone involved in the practice of healing and caring, be they nurses, doctors, healthcare aids, paramedics and all others, will continue the 'practice' of caring in the various healthcare settings to continue to truly heal rather than just dispense drugs and treatments by bringing to life the oath they take. Their flame of caring will inspire hope in the remaining sick and despairing members of society, rekindling in them the embers of hope dampened by uncaring until now.

Becoming healthy at lower costs

The PPP has a very specific agenda: one to scrutinize the over-expenditure of departments that increase the cost of operation and bring no revenue to the nation. For example, our politicians are telling us that everything will get worse: from healthcare, to crime prevention, to terrorism and now if we logically look at these statements, if everybody ends up sick there are less people paying taxes, increasing the cost of healthcare. In such, it is putting pressure on the next generation who will only be working to maintain a system where no healing is truly taking place.

The sick, the terminally ill, the despairing, the addicted, the mentally ill, will decrease in numbers due to the effects of personal caring and the restructuring within homes and communities. As a result, **health care costs will greatly diminish and health care benefits will greatly increase.** As our society continues to age, benefits and revenues to the country will continue to *increase*, as the costs of caring for the ill and aging will actually decrease, through

caring. We will see Health Care departments becoming assets, rather than liabilities as we reduce healthcare costs by 50% in three years.

Healthcare affects Everyone

Healthcare affects all of us, whether we are sick or not. It is our ‘care’ to care. As more and more people become ‘sick’ the healthy members will need to work more and more to meet the needs of the growing number of sick and will eventually become sick themselves as more and more money will be needed through taxation to meet the growing health demands. How long before all of us are working for survival only and we become sick ourselves? Then what?

The cycle must be broken. We can see the effects that ‘not caring’ has as our society becomes more and more reliant on the healthcare system. It requires more than medication and hospital beds to address our growing health issues. For people to truly heal they require living proof that someone cares beginning by our own government who must begin by seeing Canada as a family. Our government must pass laws that do not penalize the family but that enrich our families by bringing relief and hope of a better future to all people: mothers, fathers, children and seniors.

And imagine how balanced and healthy we will all be when we recognize *everyone cares*. Imagine the hope we can bring to those who may have lost it when we find ways to care for one another enough to want to make their dreams of a better life come true (become reality).

Restoring Balance by Eliminating Stress

There is a direct relationship between stress and all diseases. The proof is that physicians always recommend ‘reducing stress’ as an important step in overcoming illness and disease. They even enforce ‘no visitors’ in the case of some of their patients or restrict ‘visiting times’ in hospitals to prevent fatigue, and stress which could interfere with a person’s recovery.

A calm environment is necessary for inner balance to be maintained and a physician has the power to reduce or eliminate any factors that disturb our peace. Politicians can learn from this by eliminating all the stressors that deprive us of a balanced life by ensuring a balanced climate in the home and in the environment.

For example, the government can be much more rigorous in anti-smoking, drinking and gambling legislation which negatively affects the physical and psychological health of individuals, their families and society in general.

It is time the government becomes involved in the rehabilitation of the nation instead of viewing these dangerous addictives as money-making ventures. Consider the aftermath? How much is spent yearly on cancer treatments, on psychiatry, on social agencies to clean up after the mess has been made? The government makes one dollar on liquor taxes or lottery ticket sales and then spends two dollars in an attempt to deal with the personal and social problems

they helped to cause. The government in power uses these addictives in their money-making schemes leaving the fall-out to the next government in office to pay for the clean-up. Then the next government does the same. And so the cycle continues with no real change and no real healing. And every year, health costs rise and take their toll.

Health and the Environment

We all know there is a link between health and the environment. A toxic environment equals a wealth of health problems that ends up costing the taxpayer their income, their health and their future. We must stop paying into the pockets of corporations and multi-nationals. We must stop selling-out our resources to foreign interests who have no interest in our greatest asset: our people.

We will enforce laws that protect the families of Canada. In making sound decisions to protect the people of Canada, the environment will be protected as well. The security of our health depends on a comprehensive plan that includes good decisions made to protect our citizens and our environment. In caring for one we care for the other as each has its role in the ecosystem.

We offer a plan to minimize health costs by keeping the environment clean. Many accords have been signed and many promises of ‘a clean environment’ have been made and still pollution is worse every year and we see the price people pay with an increase in asthma and emphysema, many forms of cancer and other diseases.

Policy 7: Improving the Solicitor General's Department & Fighting Crime

The Cost of Crime

We have a proposed system that will cut down this budget instead of increasing the number of prisons and the cost of keeping a prisoner incarcerated. The department could be cut down massively while increasing the success rate of rehabilitation on a permanent basis by at least 90%. As of today there is a cost of \$81,000 per year to keep a man in jail. If he does ten years, you're nearing a million and no rehabilitation.

Breaking the Cycle

Many of who are in the prison system of today are there because of the breakdown of the family. Crime prevention does not come after the crime but begins within the home, the family. When you give the youth a balanced and stable family environment you give them the necessary tools to fight against crime instead of joining it. Gangs provide a sense of belonging but when the youth are given to feel protected and loved in their own home, they already have a sense of belonging and do not wish venture out.

Getting 'tough on crime' does not decrease crime but puts it further on the rise and creates more violent and hostile crimes. Many of the children whose fathers or mothers are in the prison system today are left to fend for themselves within a broken system that is supposed to care for them but that is preparing them to become criminals themselves because the father and/or mother is not at home. This cycle can end when those that are in prison now find they can still make a difference into their family's life on the outside. Rehabilitation also provides prevention. When one is rehabilitated they become a voice of experience and caution into the lives of others about a life of crime.

Rehabilitation

We will turn to the Canadian Forces where those in prisons could earn a career and clean out their lives in a one time opportunity where the Military would take control (since they have the training and experience of keeping war prisoners and executing planned operations to overtake people with guns, machine guns and any violent means to an end. I'm sure our criminals are not worse than that.) The Military will be used to give prisoners a formation, a career opportunity where he or she could get an education, learn mechanics, computer skills and other life skills. In such, we could give these men and women stable positions, give them a sense of responsibility and a home environment in the respect we offer to them: an opportunity to wipe out their past that usually comes from broken-down families.

Instead of the man or woman sitting in prison they would earn for themselves and their

families outside the prison walls. The man or woman, within one year, could be a law-abiding citizen that would pay taxes instead of taking from taxes, where he could look after his family instead of leaving his or her family in the welfare system and taking more from taxes. We could eliminate the welfare system and all its high costs of bureaucracy that takes more than it gives. Women and children will not be degraded and lessened because of the hard past of a spouse who ended up in jail and who never knew family values, where now through the Military they could learn moral values and make a good living for their family.

Once released and given a new lease on life, their record would be wiped out after a period of time, instead of their sentence beginning when they come out because they have a criminal record chained to them the rest of their lives. With this type of earning, education and rehabilitation they receive within prison, their chances of returning to their life of crime will drop dramatically. They will have more of a sense of strength and value of oneself and their transition into society will have already begun within prison. Freedom will be earned by learning who they are and their importance in being law-abiding citizens in this new family of Canada.

With this new prison system we are also dealing at the same time with criminality, the welfare system, and the healthcare system, which are the major costs of operation for the government of Canada - all this because of the lack of respect for the family and woman.

Policy 8: The Environment

Cleaning the Environment

Believe it or not, Canada along with other industrial countries has the reputation of being known as one of the heaviest polluters in the world. Can we be proud of this?

We will become leaders of balance and harmony with the earth. We have the blueprints for the use of alternative forms of clean energy: wind, solar, hydro-electric and human energy. We will change human activity to show respect for the natural elements. Production and consumption must compliment our environment.

As the elements respond to human behaviour and activity (for example, more driving activity equals more gas consumption equaling more pollution), we will learn how to change human activity to show more respect for the natural elements.

The nation will be cleaned, government will be cleaned and human conscience and attitude will be cleaned. When we respect and love our children, we get serious at leaving a clean future for them. The future must always be what we wish for ourselves, but for others first. We cannot leave it to the next generation.

Family Day

We will establish Sunday as Family Day. It is not in a religious way. Businesses except for essential emergency and care services will be closed thus reducing the pollution caused by the businesses themselves and the travel required to get to them. Not only will families get a break but so too, will the environment as everything slows down for this period of rest. And we all know even more could be done but this is the beginning of a much more comprehensive approach in giving families and the environment a break for in the old way (present) we set aside only one hour a year to bring relief to our environment (Earth Hour).

Securing a Safe Environment for Future Generations - No Profiteering

We will have clean air and following that, clean streets, clean homes and communities. We need to rebuild our nation by our people, for our people and with the people. Every industry in Canada, be it the lumber industry, farming industry, textiles, fishing, hunting, manufacturing, and every member of Parliament, must be part of a co-operative system working in conjunction with the needs of every Canadian.

We will end the excessive profits of corporations and foreign multi-nationals that withdraw profits and even basic necessities of life from Canadians. We will not continue the present day 'for profit only' type of thinking that is taking place when in selling our resources to other nations our resources are being depleted at an alarming rate; and where our environment usually pays the price of pollution by weakening or destroying the fragile ecosystems that have been affected.

The cost of ‘no future’ for our children and the generations to come is too high when ‘for profit only’ is the only motive of the multi-nationals and corporations. Their profiteering exploits our land and disrespects our people. For in taking what they want from the environment they rob our children of a future while leaving them only the price tag for clean-up for generations to come. Maybe the corporations and the multi-nationals should live where they work. Perhaps then more care would be taken, more respect would be given.

If we all put in a little bit of ourselves, we could wipe out the deficit and find reconciliation in a love environment with all people of Canada. Canada cannot function governed by world dictatorships. Canada must take its own family environment to become a role model for all nations in not selling off all of our resources to other nations (for example, hydro electric power and oil).

Better and Increased Crop Yields

We will encourage year-round food growth by establishing (funding) more greenhouses to make available a larger supply of fresh produce to Canadian families and at a lower cost because the extra costs associated in importing them will have been removed. Establishing year-round greenhouses would also give the over-used land a breather. Allowing fields to lie fallow every two or three years will give them an opportunity to rest between the arable years. Rest is important as it gives the soil an opportunity to replenish its minerals and its vitality; as well it is an excellent natural way of pest control, reducing and even eliminating them.

As well, we will encourage farmers and growers to engage in the ancient and proven practice of crop rotation which will not only boost crop yields but will also help in the control of pests. In this way we can maintain a productive soil with greater, more robust yields and reduce (even eliminate) the use of insecticides and pesticides which are harmful to the environment and particularly, the health of those consuming them.

In the arable year(s) we will see an increase in crop production and also an increase in the quality of foods grown: wheat, corn, flax or any other crop. As with humans, providing rest for the land shows our respect as its caretakers. Rest is necessary if we are to prevent depletion of the soil thereby depleting the minerals and vitamins in our foods and increased respect for arable land will bring about an increased awareness of the land’s true wealth in contributing to the health of all Canadians.

Policy 9: Peace, not War

Peacemakers

Canada, under the PPP will become a peacemaker, not a peacekeeper, a peacemaker. The difference is that in making peace you don't have to keep it; it is permanent. It means two sides have come together (met in the middle) and are continuing to work together to make a more peaceful and stronger tomorrow. But 'keeping the peace' is always with division between two people.

Under the PPP, Canada will not go to war. But it will thrive for peace before wars so that wars will be a thing of the past. We must look at our children of today instead of avenging those of the past. If we love the family, we will protect it, not set it up in a war zone. Canada will never be a nation with weaponries showing at every corner.

Terrorism will disappear because we will take the time to listen before we condemn as to why people are angry; why they wish to destroy. They don't want to be dominated and many nations have by far more respect for women in their spiritual values than those who write on their monies "In God We Trust" while we promote pornography, sexual abuse, drugs, incest and breakdown in the family.

The New Role of the Canadian Forces

The Canadian Forces will be transformed. The opportunity to learn and receive an education through the Military will still be available but the Military will now become an organization of making peace and not be used to create wars or continue wars.

They will become relief workers in our own country and that of others: trained for distribution of food for the poor, search and rescue, the aide in rebuilding a community after the destruction of a natural disaster, a war or because of poverty. They will be the front-leaders in training other nations to 'fish' rather than to have someone fish for them.

They will be in care of the rehabilitation of those within the prison system, changing today's Canadian war makers into Canadian peacemakers of tomorrow. They will teach them life skills, discipline and the value and importance of oneself, while giving them the training they need to be active part-takers in society.

The old role of the Military will be unnecessary because everyone is being given a vision and hope for a new life rather than the domination of the past which leads to survival only. When fear and anger is replaced with hope and love, that is when the true rebuilding of a nation (and nations) begins. The transformation of the Canadian Forces will lead to the transformation of the world. It will become a role model to other Military Forces around the world of what can be achieved by love and respect.

Policy 10: Unity

Everyone must be involved in the process of unity...the people, the church and the government.

Understanding One Another

It is by *understanding* that unity begins; and understanding begins with listening. It begins by listening to one another, understanding one another, and then finally working together to plan a better future for all regardless of the obstacles we have created by pride and prejudice which is what works contrary to what is necessary to bring about a *unified* Canada.

Today we are asking everyone – to come forward to begin the transformation of Canada by first beginning to believe in our country and then by learning how to talk together. Listening is the first step in understanding one another. It is in this way that peace among Canadians will begin.

It has been said, ‘If anyone loses, nobody wins.’ We must learn to share with one another freely and honestly the vast resources of our Nation. True sharing means there is no one greater and no one lesser. All are equal and as such, are equal partakers as to the wealth of the Nation. And we have to want it for others, just as we want it for ourselves.

Listening to One Another

If there are no divisions, then there is unity. Unity begins with sharing: both sides listening to what the other has to say. Who in Canada doesn’t want a better future? We all dream of a Canada with prosperity, freedom, peace and security. But, we must want this for everyone. Beginning with this *dream* and then following the steps together, we can begin to build this new home, Canada. Remember, it begins with hope. But for **belief** to replace hope there must be proof that we are willing to work together. Once there is proof, belief replaces hope because now we are working together to make the dream become a Reality.

Provinces and Territories

No more war, Canada! Wars of the heart created by the things we use to differentiate ourselves and thereby, separate ourselves from others by ideas born of pride: differences in geography by provinces and territories (where we live and where our ‘interests’ lie); differences in social status (the few have’s and the many have not’s); and partiality caused by differences in race, beliefs (non-beliefs), colour or gender, all lead to separation, fighting and break-up. These personal ‘wars’ have divided and broken more than personal relationships – they have torn our country apart.

We are not here because I am ‘red’, ‘blue’, ‘orange’ or ‘green’ or because I am from Calgary, Montreal or St. John’s but for everyone to learn how to love from the heart because you realize finally (and honestly), ***We are all together.*** We will retain the unity of the country by building a

solid federation of provinces and territories. In a productive nation, everyone works for the well-being of others. British Columbia, Quebec, the Maritimes and all others are part of the family of Canada where *every member is unique, distinct, but not better*.

Each province will work for the well-being of the others beginning by dialogue and not by making ‘swiss cheese’ of Canada with too many distinctions. We will not change the word ‘province’ or ‘territory’ to ‘nation’. **Canada must stop being a nation and become a family.** A family is never functioning politically - in a democratic way, much less in a socialist way. The PPP will guide us to unity in the spirit of a true family.

We are one nation under God. (*See the Canadian Constitution.*)

The Rich and the Poor

We will end the real division towards unity in this nation – the division created by the rich elite bureaucracy over the rest of the country.

In every country in the world – it is always the ‘rich against the poor’ because the ‘rich’ have made themselves more important. The poor will think they are dreaming when all the people *come together*. They will say, ‘Is it a dream? The people love us?’ Imagine how easy it will be when everyone loves from the heart. Only the *Spirit* of love could do this - teach us to love each other!

We are there for peace and love - for the poor to dream and for their dreams to become reality instead of drugs and alcohol, and crime. Where even though many years ago Stats Canada said it would be impossible for people to ever work again after two years of unemployment; but we tell you today, when your country finally loves you they will see all poor people believe so much that they will work every day with all of you.

Human Rights & Equality

We will also open the hearts of all people, rich or poor that have taken advantage of the great gifts that Canada offers by its freedom and to earn a living; where one could look after their family in a better way by becoming part of a greater family in absolute equality.

It is not buildings or billboards or museums of ‘human rights’ that will convince the nation of their supposed purpose. Rather when unity and human rights exist, we will divert the funding of ‘white elephants’ into housing and into reinstating the First Nations people and the poor to *become one* with the rest of Canada.

The Media

For the media (TV and radio) – it is time to be honest and to believe in your country where all the people are together finally. If you truly loved your country you would allow the smaller

parties without resources (the poorer parties) free broadcast time to share with all the people. The media is an important tool to bring unity to Canada and also the world. Every country will learn from our country because Canada will look like a dream to them.

We look forward to any opportunity to express ourselves to the people of Canada and you, the media have a major role to play in the affairs of this nation. And we will never take away from you, the media, the freedom to express your own comments and views that will enrich the nation, perhaps by your comments to enhance the beauty of this family that Canada will be.

We are looking forward to the beginning of a relationship between the media and the ideas of a better nation as you all continue your integrity in reporting by honouring your creed as a reporter in seeking the Truth always and without bias.

On Separating Church & State

Should it be so or should it not be so? Interfaith conflicts pertaining to every religion (also non-religious people, perhaps atheist, communist, socialist, democratic) - anything that becomes division in the nation, must come to an end. We emphasize the unacceptability of the interference of Governments in the affairs of different religions, other than to become a mediator - one that could bring together the spirit of love, justice, equality and most of all, respect to the fullest that should be rooted into the base of any faith. However, if respect is absent because of the freedom of expression, respect should override freedom of expression. We need to respect woman, the family, the communities and all faiths.

Therefore, as this is presented to the government and the churches, the government must reinstate, through the churches proper education and proper knowledge of a just and fair and equal way for all people. The responsibility lies within the heart of all the inhabitants of this nation and North America. And it is a duty for the whole nation to partake in its own restoration.

All inhabitants of this land must be re-educated in a new history of Canada where justice and truth will be brought to all people and those who have been brain-washed with hatred towards the First Nation people must be re-educated in discovering the true value of the First Nation people.

Healing must begin in all places: the media, the federal government and the churches. Before anyone undertakes to bring healing to others, they must themselves become healed. How will we know when this has happened? The permanent sign of satisfaction will be in the peace that will come to all hearts. Then you will have come to a time of peace.

Policy 11: The Wealth of Canada

I. A Balanced Nation

Canada could be 'balanced' if the government stopped throwing away money 'for nothing' - on wars; on lies like the museum of 'human rights'; and on ad campaigns about how 'beautiful' Canada is. Then there would be money available to create *peace* in the homes and communities and including the government of Canada and there would be enough money finally to pay everyone like the First Nations people what they owe them. It cannot be said, 'We have no money to pay for this!' Today it is important to be 'balanced' to pay what you owe. Imagine, past governments waste money on the war, on ad campaigns while saying, 'We have no money to pay the Indian people!' and 'We have no money for the youth!'

But no one person or group is more important than the other: we can only *win* by loving each other and by working together freely. We cannot 'force' people to do things like Russia does. This will never happen here! Never! Learn to love your country and learn to hold each other from the heart.

What is more important today (not in a religious way or like the Communists who believe nothing) is to **learn to love from your heart** –that's all. Don't talk all day without love. It won't mean anything. Learn and share with the people. Teach them to *be love* together. For the first time they will say, 'I am so happy for Canada. I believe in Canada!'

II. Ending Poverty by working together...rich and poor.

Poverty in Canada (and Worldwide) will be overcome by our ability to remove its shadow completely - through recognizing each other and the assets that we are to each other and the nation. **We will invest in the people through education**, so that all will have the opportunity to strengthen and multiply the natural resources of Canada - our youth. This will be the foundation of establishing human rights in everyone's heart.

We invite, in the name of justice, all the poor communities of this nation to join forces with our brothers and sisters, so neglected by racism and injustice ... as all the poor of this nation are dominated by the rich, who will always use money to keep people under control through sanctions. Disrespect of anyone, by anyone of any station in life, must be discontinued.

We will unite together as a majority family, where everyone is included *with no exception* as to their race, religion, financial status or poverty; without any form of partiality; or elite thinking. Canada is the family that will gather the world by the example of its own *family environment* that will give equality to all and diminish poverty to become wealth - a commonwealth of all people.

We will have a federal law prohibiting the cutting off of hydro, heat and water under any circumstance, other than emergency repairs. All rental units will be responsible for including

utilities within the rent. A landlord will be required to follow this law or be charged with criminal negligence or theft from the tenant.

Respect for women and the family is the key to ending the welfare system. Canada will no longer need a welfare system. Until then, Family Services or social agencies that would put people with children on the streets will be deemed criminally responsible. Provincial transfer payments from Ottawa will be eliminated towards provinces involved in such activities.

We will make it a criminal offence for agencies to have neglected people and caused them to sleep on the streets, winter or summer, for whatever reason, be it that they are drug addicts, alcoholics, or mentally unfit. Adequate housing will have to be provided for everyone.

The social services system will receive praise for ensuring people's security; thereby, making them no longer dependent on the welfare system. Again, money saved in this way, will become an asset for the community and Government, by having costs decreased, all down the line. Social assistance costs will be reverted into investment, beginning by hope to those who have become dependent on agencies.

Caring for people is a political issue. Caring will prevent welfare, prostitution, addiction, suicide and all forms of negative involvement. Again, the entire welfare system can be eliminated, where everyone will experience the joy of re-building communities for the well-being of all.

It is greater to turn a liability into an asset than to ignore it, because an asset will always bring back to the nation the bearing of fruit of the work of the people. The taxpayers, you and I, are the employers of the Social Service Agencies. We will prohibit those agencies from endangering the lives of women and children in Canada and creating an enormous tax burden for the citizens of this country.

We will guarantee security to our own people.

III. We will end the excessive profits of corporations and multi-nationals that through their greed, withdraw profits and even basic necessities of life from their countrymen, women and children. The elite are in minority. The poor and the 'becoming poor' are in majority: it is they who will speak on Election Day, with no 'money power' to manipulate the destiny of the majority. We will bring stability to the **standard of living**, where now excessive profits for large corporations are the cause of our living expense increases, which make it impossible for the average family to even wish to be living the joy of the family.

- (i) **Education or training and upgrading in skills or trades** will be provided for anyone that shows an interest in bettering his or her life and that of others, where we could have workers and their goods 'made in Canada' rather than importing them from other nations, because of the struggle within our own.

- (ii) Local initiatives of real value will benefit communities who will no longer have to depend on social assistance and repayments of government debts. The time is ripe for these ventures, as industries are shutting down all over Canada.

As companies leave, for whatever reasons, with our support, communities can step up and become managers of their own industries: for example using lumber for their own housing rather than pulp and paper mills.

- (iii) **The needs of our farmers must be met** before international markets take over to corrupt local exchanges. We have government surpluses that can be used to support the needs of the farmers to hold onto their farms. We will put money back into agriculture. To make sure that we have food in the city, we must ensure that we support our farmers to grow the food. Farmers must receive what is due them, in order to survive in their ventures. They will be supported with their costs of production. Likewise, our forestry and our fisheries. Remember this wise proverb.

*‘Only after the last tree has been cut down,
Only after the last river has been poisoned,
Only after the last fish has been caught,
Only then, will you find that money cannot be eaten.’*

We will invest in the establishment of more greenhouses so that the foods that can be grown this way are available for year-round consumption. This will relieve our dependency on foreign countries for certain foods and make them more cost efficient for Canadian consumers. As well, it will provide year-long employment for those employed in food production.

IV. All natural resources of the land belong to every tax payer.

We will become one nation, where all belongs to all people. As one resource becomes depleted or useless in one area, we are thankful that another resource in another part of the country can be our life-preserver. Hydro-electric power, a clean, renewable source of energy, is quickly becoming an acceptable, thus profitable source of energy of which all provinces would appreciate a percentage.

We will ensure equality of Canada’s wealth among all provinces and territories. We will address ‘transfer payments’ to the provinces so that no province and none of its’ inhabitants become ‘have-nots’ within the Family of Canada.

Policy 12: Employment

Working Together in Full Respect

The PPP is not a military venture. It is a logic venture. Presently, our laws are like screaming and we could never justify them other than impose them. Because if they don't mean much to ourselves, how could we explain them to others? It is just like the law in making it compulsory to hire minorities such as First Nation, Filipino, Italian, Greek, East Asian, or Middle Eastern. We must welcome these people with their skills and to be prepared to share our skills with them so that this nation will be a productive nation where everyone will work for the well-being of the others. It is the only way, through respect, that we could bring under control the high cost of living, while poverty increases.

Profit-Sharing

Exploiting others is hatred against them. To welcome them and be fair to each other, only then you will have a nation that will stand where every worker could share in the form of shares in the profits that now are too excessive for some and lesser for others.

Foreign ownership will have limited access to profits that could leave the country. They will have to invest into their employees in the form of shares with dividends where everyone will work for his or her own company. As such, you will have better employees. They will keep their jobs longer and everyone will have a sense of *living*.

Imagine two people working for the same company and they know how to be fair in the margins of profit because you would not want to do to your friend that works with you what he could also do to you: exploit you. So the margin of profit will become the multiple of revenue, where percentage will mean less but volume will mean more work. The volume will bring balance to the excessive profit for some, which makes it impossible for their own employees to buy what they produce.

Valuing the Employee

We will re-instate the value of the workers: corporations now are quadrupling the profits by having everyone working on a part-time basis where they do away with their involvement with CPP (Canada Pension Plan), Workers' Compensation, private pension plan and the possibilities of wage increase; while the cost of goods increase and certainly not because of the wage increase.

The Canada Pension Plan, known as CPP, is literally empty, where now the government of Canada takes funding from the RRSP's to cover up for what they took out of CPP that was supposed to be in trust to the people. What will be the next scheme to put the money back in RRSP's?

Financing of all assets of the nation

Budgets will be balanced by cost-reduction and increased productivity. We could operate with fewer costs and increase the revenues. We will outline, in details, our financial policies where we could cut down the budget of the federal government, decrease the income tax system while increasing revenues because of dead investments by the government that produce no revenue while increasing in cost to the taxpayer every year. This is unacceptable.

We will invest in our youth and in all the people of this Nation through education, so that all will have the opportunity to strengthen and multiply the natural resources of this country – our youth. We will develop a national education system, using the media and technology, where everyone will have an opportunity, at a much lower cost, to learn to grow. In this way, we will begin a foundation of establishing human rights in everyone’s heart without the need of expensive museums. Our priority is to give everyone to look forward to tomorrow without pressures and divisions between people. Everyone will set his or her dream, a goal, and will be encouraged to go for it.

Policy 13: True Representation in Serving the People

Representatives of the People

Instead of fighting others all day on ‘issues’ that separate us in order to win, it is time for all of us to move away from pride and prejudice where we did not care about the people in the past. But respect the people now, and realize *who you are* – that you are *with the people* because you finally recognize *they look like you*.

Let’s get together people, and prove to the young that they will be happy because there is no longer any anger, no longer separation between people anymore, and that we are honest now in our love for one another. Let’s talk together and forget the ‘colours’! The important thing is to be humble – not proud. And because ‘fighting’ has been replaced by *caring*, everyone’s stress will be reduced leading to a balanced nation.

Unless you convince the people by the reality in your heart of what you say, rather than election promises, only by this reality will Canada be without opposition: where the 308 seats in Parliament shall no longer be divided in two, much less in four; where all heads will work together and the people that have trusted us first shall be the ones that we serve by their participation in working along with us to remedy the ailment of this nation.

As duly elected representatives of the people, constituencies (the people) will have the say as to whether their representative is truly representing them as was promised on Election Day. As the **true power**, it is up to the people to determine whether he or she should be fired. And it is up to the people, to elect another representative if they feel the current one has not been accountable to them and is not working in their best interests.

A True Leader

We are looking forward to reaching out to this nation unlike politicians seeking office by destroying each other’s reputation and false promises in playing musical chairs in the House of Commons. What is our political experience in leadership, you may ask? The errors of all previous politicians have instructed us in not following their educational background and experience that has led us to the mess we are in. We have no experience like them. They taught us how not to.

It is simple: a doctor is not a dentist, much less a carpenter or a plumber. But everyone is an expert at what one has sought to become. We will look for these experts, but the top priority is that they live in a family environment themselves, not by abandoning their families but in living as true family people in order to understand the structure of the PPP. Only these people will be accepted to head departments that work for the well-being of every member of this nation.

The Leader of the PPP will work for no wages, devoting her life to serving and in re-structuring broken-down families because of the injustice of our governmental society that so neglects the

family. She intends to continue in this way, the work of a Mission: where everyone will know the love of a mother (and a father) that could look after the well-being of all their children.

We are not a Party that will sit on a fence just for the joy of being called a ‘Party’. The family that we envision will become reality and we will not increase the deficit in order to please the people with electoral promises that they end up paying for by increasing the deficit to satisfy them. In a family, everyone must sacrifice. Such it will be.

May you be blessed by whatever form of belief that must take its roots in a family environment, justice and equality through respect for all. May your prayers and wishes be answered always with the well being of others first. In such, they will learn how to look after you.

Policy 14: The Budget of Canada

Together we will achieve a major surplus in Canada's budget finally ending the Nation's deficit.

- (i) **People's needs will be our first priority.** You will have confidence in this new government which will lead you not into debts, but benefits, through honesty, moral value, real participatory democracy and by being servants of the people.
- (ii) **This government will be totally transparent and accountable.** There will be no massive bills for investigations into frauds or money scandals. Multi-million dollar funds for such ventures as museums for 'human rights' will be stopped and redirected to addressing the poverty and human rights of our people, in all parts of the country.

As well, there will be no secrets in government and no 'closed doors'. Everything will be opened up to the people: the full accounting of the business of the government of Canada which is its' people. All records, audits, incomes and in short all finances of the government will be available at all times for public viewing.

It then becomes the obligation of every citizen of Canada to 'watch the books', as it is the people who are the employers of the people who represent them.

- (iii) **We will cut the income tax *completely*** within a five year period and show an increase in revenue at the same time. We will reduce department budgets (because of their mismanagement and lack of accountability) to a minimum, while attaining a greater success rate. The sales tax will be sufficient tax revenue because of the budget cuts that will be recycled into profitable ventures.

The GST could eventually be phased out completely, but first, used to pay off our obligations to the First Nation people, not only because of treaties but because it is rightfully due to them. In the rebuilding phase, ventures such as development of a local forestry industry could be turned into employment for the young aboriginal men and women, where the housing and living conditions could be improved.

- (iv) **We will eliminate unnecessary departments** that are like white elephants and turn them into profitable ventures for the taxpayers, so that ultimately, Canada could operate *with a sales tax only and no income tax at all*.
- (v) **Through profit-sharing**, every one will participate in work that will benefit families and communities, rather than exploiting others. Every worker will share in the profits of businesses, thus increasing incentive for good work.
- (vi) **We will limit excessive corporate profits** where dividends will be returned to the employees and the province in order to regenerate health and revenue. Better

employees will create stability within the companies and within the families of the employees.

- (vii) **Technology will not replace the worker**, in such, increasing our liability, through unemployment, welfare systems, costs for retraining, and corporate buy-outs. However, technology will continue to serve a purpose in helping people do their jobs.
- (viii) **Volunteerism from those with wisdom and caring and experience will be encouraged**, to help others to improve techniques, skills and abilities and expand their learning.

In Conclusion...

We ask you not to look for reasons not to believe, because everything we propose is very cost efficient. Everyone would benefit: we would have safer streets, safer homes, less criminality in the home as out on the street where Canada would be our native land, whether we were born here or not and where everyone **would see this simple reality make such a difference in their lives**.

We invite everyone to open up, meeting anywhere, where we will speak and answer your questions from coast to coast. And you the Inuit people and the First Nations, wherever you are in this nation: we want to meet you. We want to show you that you and all people of this nation in the prison system, in hospitals or seniors anywhere are our Family.

We invite family-oriented people to the candidacy of the PPP. You may be a good chartered accountant; you may be good with finances of different departments. We want loyal people. Your top priority should be that you are loyal to your own family. If you're not loyal to your own family, you can't be to a bigger one. But what we are doing for Canada in making it a family is that we are seeking nothing for ourselves but everything for all.

We have no political opponents because anyone that could show us better than a family environment, we could walk with you. But politicians have to stop looking for the title and the prestige of a position where everyone goes for his own dream and his own ego and never for the benefit of the people.

The proof is: look at the mess we're in. The nation is like a broken-down family where the kids have gone astray; people don't believe in the family anymore in the nation - all as a result of this corruption, mismanagement or total ignorance. Neither one is acceptable when you have the lives of the people in your hands.

Thank you for reading. We remind you that **we are a centre party** inviting anyone in the centre and to grow from there. Democracy is to mean **freedom**. And freedom has no cost to it. We show you our plan. We don't make you promises of tons of dollars in your pocket. We tell you that we could make it be what you read but only by working together. Everyone must take part. We must stop expecting 'lotteries' everyday from our government. We must be fair with others. By being fair with others **together we will make it**.
